Compost Facility	\$9/CuFt
Fencing	\$3/ft
Field Boarder Pollinator Habitat	\$979/acre
Irrigation Water Management	\$500/farm/year
High Tunnel Implementation	\$2.57/SqFt
Conservation Cover for Pollinators	\$987/acre
Cover Crops	\$188/acre (irrigated) \$168/acre (non-irrigated)
Herbaceous Wind Barrier	\$2/ft
Nutrient Management	\$584/farm/year

Payments made either directly or indirectly to a producer or legal entity enrolled in the Organic Initiative are subject to an annual payment limitation of \$20,000 per fiscal year (September 30) with a maximum program payment limit of \$80,000 during a 6 year period between 2009 and 2014.
